Why is benefit and value realisation important?

Benefits realisation will enable the Partnership to articulate direct and indirect benefits and demonstrate value being achieved. Consistent and aligned articulation of benefits will:

- Provide an evidence base for reporting and tracking the success of clinical academic innovations
- Enable learning and sharing across the Partnership and beyond
- Support publications of the impact of the initiatives
- Support reporting outputs across the Partnership (e.g. existing internal governance)
- Develop a case for future funding (capital and revenue funding)
- Ensure continued organisational support

To achieve this and with support from the Programme team we are asking each clinical academic innovation initiative to create a benefit map in line with their project plans.

Benefits Mapping Approach

The partnership programme team is working with clinical/operational teams to map benefits in line with the following approach and categories.

Enabler

Aspect of the partnership that allows a series of changes to be made (see below enablers list)

Changes

A clinical or academic change facilitated by an enabler and produces a desirable outcomes

Outcome

The result of a change:

Different to a benefit as

outcomes on their own may not clearly demonstrate value for stakeholders

Benefits

The benefit of an outcome:

- A measurable improvement
- Resulting from Change
- Advantageous by at least one stakeholder
- Contributes to Partnership objectives
- The value perceived or realised by those experiencing the outcome of change

Benefits will be mapped to the following themes:

- 1. Clinical Outcome
- 2. Safety/ Quality
- 3. Patient and Staff Experience
- Resource sustainability
