<b>Was the correct advice given for timing of cervical screening?</b>
"No idea"
"Unsure"
"None mentioned"
"They didn't"
"During and at 6 week check"
"Had conflicting advice as to when I could have my smear after birth"
"Not that I'm aware of"
"Not told"
"I wasn't advised but thought it was 6 months the practice nurse later informed me 3 months postnatal is suitable"
"I'm on medication and was told to book it soon"
<b>What would make it easier for you to have your cervical screening postnatally?</b>
"Someone telling me when I need one"
"More information on what it involves"
"Straightforward advice as to exactly when I could have one after birth would have been useful... I just wanted a time frame"
"Better education on when you can/can't have it etc"
"I had a letter inviting me 10 months after birth, I attended"
"Ensuring everyone gets an invite and more info on the letter regards to what to do if pregnant, when in cycle etc"
"More reminders!!"
"A letter being invited in to have one, or being told to book one if needed"
"GP reminder"
"Smear tests in the evening now childcare is a factor"
"Evening appointment worked for me as I could have childcare"
