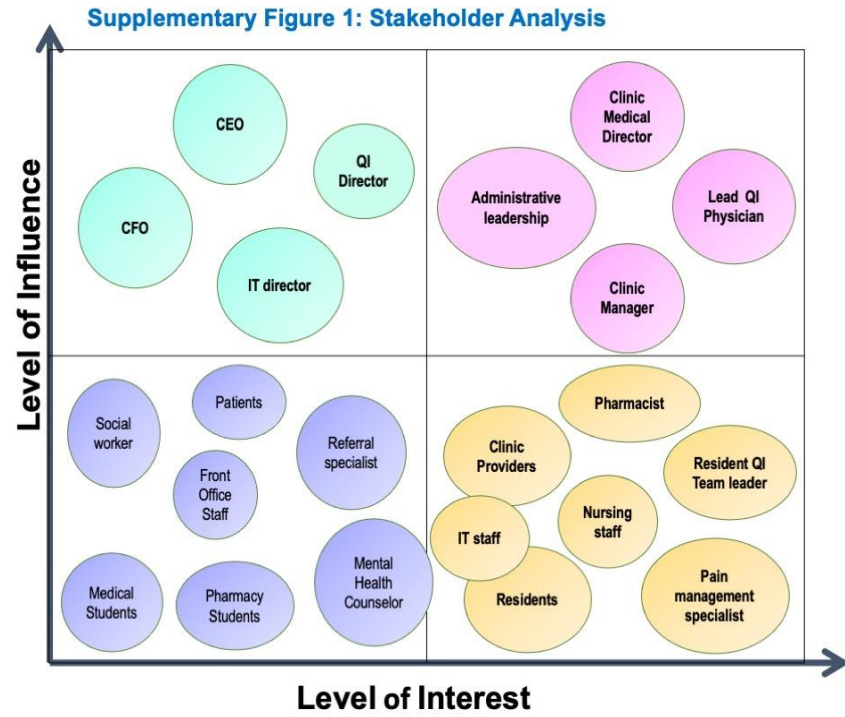


Table S1. STEEEP Table: Safe Opioid Prescribing Quality Improvement Project	
Safe	Following CDC guidelines and state regulation regarding recommendation of chronic opioid therapy management for non-cancer pain to improve patient safety
Timely	Patients on chronic opiate therapy are identified from monthly EPCS reports, EHR database created for tracking, quarterly comprehensive pain visits and at least biannual urine toxicology, interprofessional team engagement for timely care for patients and for providers who give cares.
Effective	Utilize evidence-based protocols for safe opioid prescribing & evidence-based management of chronic non-cancer pain.
Efficient	Reduce morbidity & mortality, and health care utilization cost from adverse effects of chronic opioid use.
Equitable	Offer to all patients regardless of socioeconomic status, race, and ethnicity.
Patient Centered	Implement providers' training on shared decision making & patient Centered approach for chronic pain management.
